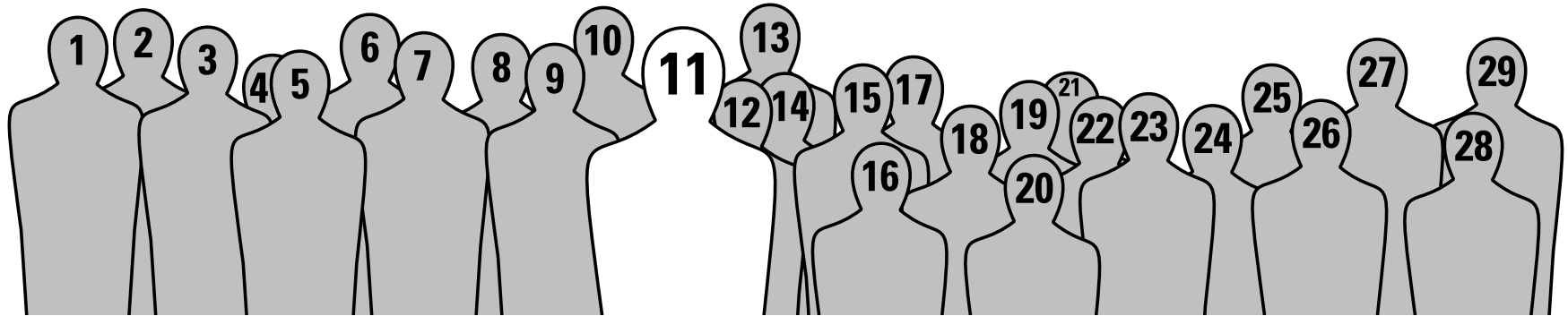

The Huddersfield Singers is a chamber choir with a membership of around forty singers. The choir was originally formed in 1875 as the **Huddersfield Glee & Madrigal Society** and performs a wide variety of sacred and secular music from all periods of musical history, ranging from the mediæval to the present day.

The choir changed its name to **The Huddersfield Singers** in 1985 in recognition of the fact that its repertoire had become far more wide-ranging than the former name implied. Today, the choir is renowned for its adventurous and interesting repertoire, and takes pride in performing pieces by less well-known composers alongside mainstream works.
